Frequently Asked Questions

Who is the general contractor for this project? A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. is the low bidder. It is expected they will be awarded the contract at the July 24, 2018 Village Board Meeting.

What hours will the contractor be permitted to work? The contractor is permitted to work between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, and between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturday. However, work is generally not performed on Saturdays unless absolutely necessary to complete the project in a timely manner. Work is not permitted on Sundays or Holidays. Per Village ordinance the Contractor's work force is allowed to assemble on site prior to 7 a.m. however no work that generates significant noise is allowed before 7 a.m.

Why is the contractor digging in the parkway in front of my house? The project scope of work involves regrading parkway ditches and swales, the installation of storm sewers, and the installation of new storm sewer inlets. Generally all project work will be taking place in Village right of way. At the completion of the project all areas that are disturbed by this work will be restored using the same materials as were originally in place.

How will the lawn area in front of my house be restored? All disturbed lawn areas will be restored with topsoil and seed.

Will school buses, mail delivery, garbage pickup, and recycling pickup be affected by the project? The Village of Northbrook provides a copy of this notice to the local school districts, park district, mail and refuse services. All efforts are made to accommodate the normal operation of these services. However, these service providers may elect to change their routes and/or delivery/pick up times.

When will the project be completed? The contract completion date is November 15, 2018.

Why isn't the Contractor working today? The project involves work at three separate locations. It is likely the contractor's forces are working at one of the other project locations if weather is good and you don't see them on your street. Work at all three project sites must be completed by the November 15, 2018 completion date.

Who can I contact if I have questions or need assistance? The Village has contracted with Atlas Engineering Group, Ltd. (AEG) to serve as the resident engineer for the project. 
Sign Up for Special Updates from the Village of Northbrook

This guide will show you how to sign-up to receive e-mail about a specific project or item with the Village's NotifyMe program.

Step 1: Visit the Village's website at www.northbrook.il.us/notifyme

Step 2: Enter Your E-mail Address & Sign In

Enter your e-mail address to create an "account" (this step creates a temporary account that allows you to subscribe to one or more lists or sign-up for e-mail notices). Once you've entered your e-mail address, click "Sign In"




Step 3: Select Your Preferences for E-mail Click on the Icons Below to Subscribe

When you "sign in," the site will ask you if you prefer to receive HTML e-mails (which include graphics and look like website pages) or regular text-only e-mails. Once you have set those preferences, you can subscribe to individual lists.

Step 4: Confirm Your Subscription

Once you click on a list to subscribe, you will receive an e-mail asking you to confirm your subscription. Simply follow the instructions in that e-mail and you are now subscribed to notices on the individual project you signed up for.



Step 5: Manage Your Subscription

You can unsubscribe from a subscription at any time by scrolling to the bottom of any e-mail you get and clicking "unsubscribe" or by returning to this page and entering your e-mail address and manually unsubscribing.
