The Northbrook Grand Prix bike race will be held on **July 24** as part of the *Chicago Grit series (formerly Intelligentsia Cup)*. You are receiving this letter because your home or business is on or very near the race course and you will likely be impacted by this daylong event. The first bike race begins at 11am and the last race ends at 8pm.

Road Closures and Detour

Beginning at 5am on Thursday, July 24, parts of Shermer, Meadow, Walters, and Church streets will be closed to traffic to give the race organization a safe work zone to set up the racecourse. All roads will be reopened by 11pm. Residents whose homes are along the racecourse will need to ensure their vehicles are removed from the racecourse prior to the closure of the course. Parking

The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) has arranged with Meadowbrook School for impacted residents to use the parking lot at 1600 Walters Avenue the night before and during the race day. Interested residents will need to submit, either electronically or by mail, an Agreement and Release of Liability waiver to District 28. Access Parking Passes

For residents and businesses who live behind St. Norbert's and between Anets Drive and Spruce Street, a special parking pass is included in this letter for in/out access along Lorenz Drive. 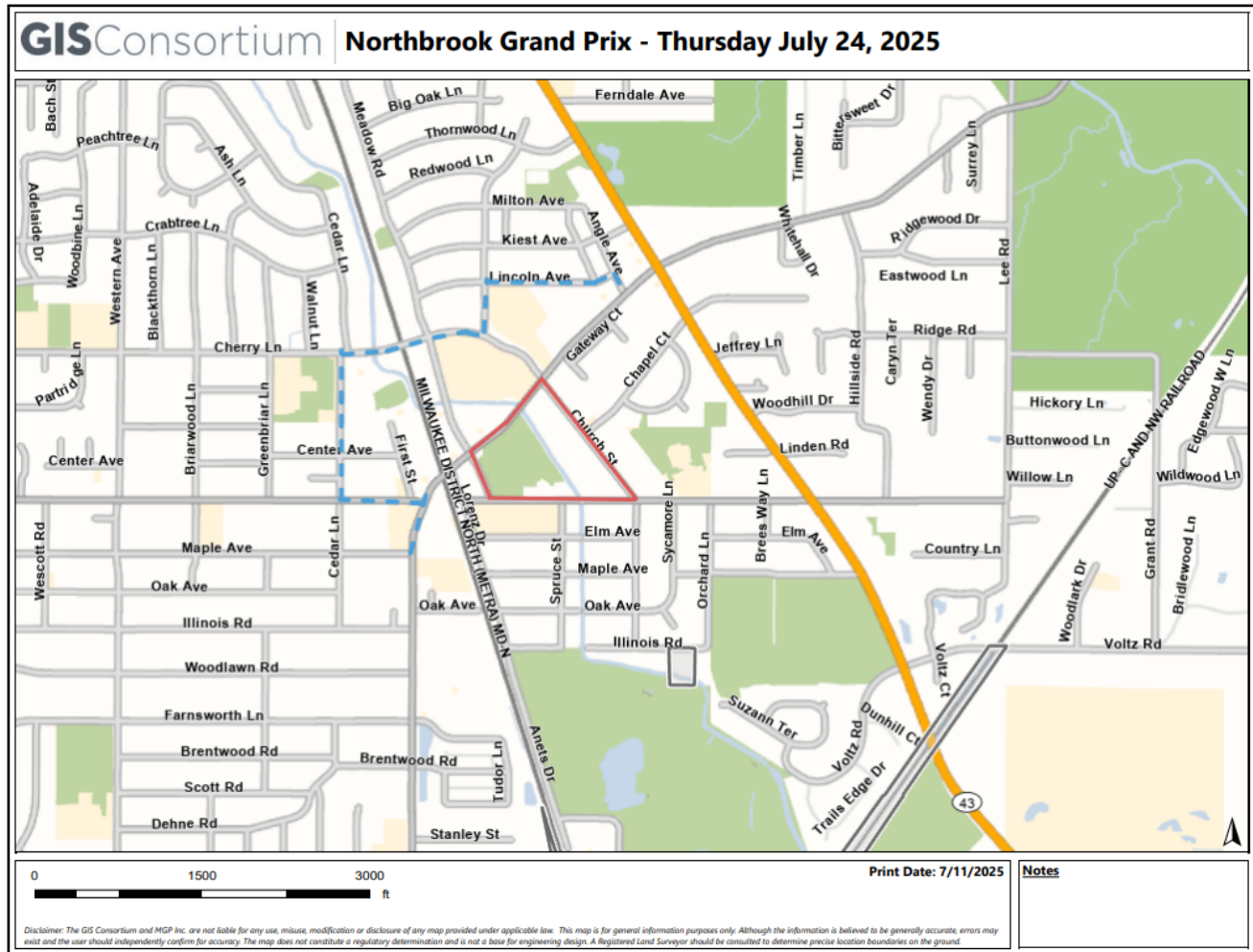
